frequently asked questions

Does Porescreen SPF 40 really blend into all skin tones? Why does it look white when it comes out of the tube?

A: Yes, this product is suitable for different skin tones. It comes out white because of the Zinc Oxide in the formula, but the white appearance dissipates as you blend it onto the skin, leaving a hint of tint or sheer finish.

How should this product be applied?

A: To ensure this blendable, mineral sunscreen leaves a sheer finish suitable for different skin tones it's important to shake well. Then, apply evenly and liberally to face, preferably 15 minutes prior to sun exposure. Can be worn alone or underneath make-up.

Which is more important: SPF number or frequency of application?

A: Application, by far! While SPF numbers matter we recommend wearing at least an SPF 30), whether your client will wear a sunscreen daily – and correctly – matters more.

Why is this product ideal for sun protection post-treatment?

A: Zinc Oxide is unlikely to irritate sensitive skin, which makes it a reliable choice for skin that has undergone a treatment.

Should this product be used even if my clients are not regularly outdoors?

A: Yes! UV rays are always present, even on rainy or cloudy days; and they can penetrate glass. Besides that, blue light is everywhere, which is why it is imperative for clients to wear sunscreen daily and indoors.

Will this product look invisible and wear well under make-up?

A: Yes! With all sunscreens, please advise your client to wait until their sunscreen feels dry before they apply make-up over it. This formula blurs and smooths skin with a primer-like effect while encapsulated light-reflective tint enhances skin tone with a sheer finish – perfect for wearing under make-up.

Which moisturizer can I layer with Porescreen SPF 40?

A: We recommend applying a moisturizer like Active Moist or Skin Smoothing Cream before layering on Porescreen SPF 40.
