- **Glycolic Acid** has the smallest molecular size among AHAs, allowing it to help shed built-up layers of skin, clear pores, and help to even skin tone.
- Lactic Acid is an AHA with exfoliating, brightening and hydrating benefits.
- **Salicylic Acid**, an oil-soluble BHA, loosens the bonds between dead skin cells aiding in the exfoliation of old keratinocytes to exfoliate, unclog pores, and even skin texture.
- **Gluconolactone**, a plant-based PHA (Polyhydroxy Acid) with a large molecular structure, gently exfoliates skin's surface helping to minimize sensitization as it delivers antioxidant benefits.
- **Tranexamic Acid**, derived from the amino acid Lysine, helps to brighten skin and minimize hyperpigmentation.
- **Phytic Acid** helps even skin tone and minimize hyperpigmentation while also delivering antioxidant benefits.
- Fermented Pomegranate Enzyme, extracted from unused fruit pulp, helps to exfoliate the outermost layer of dead skin cells that trap bacteria and sebum.
- A moisturizing lipid-rich blend with **ceramides, upcycled Cranberry Extract** and **Red Gardenia Flower Extract** promotes radiant, long-lasting hydration.

how to use it

Massage evenly onto dry, cleansed skin. Leave on for 1-3 minutes, then rinse. Begin by using every other day, noting skin's response and building up to daily use. You may experience tingling as the product activates. For daytime use, follow with a moisturizer and SPF.

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frequently asked questions

How does Liquid Peelfoliant fit into my client's existing regimen and professional treatment schedule?

Because Liquid Peelfoliant immediately delivers more radiant, glowing skin, we recommend using it in the morning. It should be used on clean, dry skin, and before applying targeted treatments or moisturizers. Clients may begin by using every other day, and gradually increasing to daily usage.

How often can my client use Liquid Peelfoliant?

Your client can use Liquid Peelfoliant as often as daily. Build up to daily use by beginning with every other morning for the first week. We do not recommend using Liquid Peelfoliant more than once per 24-hour period.

Can I use other exfoliants with this?

Liquid Peelfoliant's 30% concentration of acids and enzymes makes it quite potent – so most clients will not feel the need to use other exfoliants on days when they use Liquid Peelfoliant. However, a separate daily exfoliant may be used as tolerated if desired.

What skin conditions benefit from use?

Those with resilient skin and uneven skin tone, fine lines and wrinkles, dullness, or enlarged pores can benefit from Liquid Peelfoliant.

Will my client's skin visibly peel?

No; their skin should not visibly shed with daily use of Liquid Peelfoliant. Unlike treatment room peels that can leave clients' skin with tightness or peeling, Liquid Peelfoliant leaves skin instantly brighter, smoother, and more luminous.

Can my client use Liquid Peelfoliant near the eye area?

As with any at-home exfoliant, advise clients to use caution and avoid applying Liquid Peelfoliant too close to the eye area.

How long should my client wait after receiving a professional peel treatment?

In general, we recommend waiting at least 1-2 weeks post-professional peel before using any at-home peel products. Your client's dedication to a professional peel after-care regimen, as well as their lifestyle and skin sensitivity, should also be taken into consideration.

What are the differences between Dermalogica's Rapid Reveal Peel and Liquid Peelfoliant?

Though both products are professional-grade at-home peels they feature different active ingredients, provide different benefits, and have different application usage instructions.

Why is Liquid Peelfoliant pink?

The pinkish color of Liquid Peelfoliant is derived from antioxidant-rich Red Gardenia Flower Extract. Its scent comes from a blend of Raspberry, Rosa Damascena and Bergamot Oil.

Can my client use a chemical SPF after using Liquid Peelfoliant?

Yes. Although this peel is a maximum-strength at-home peel, it does not result in downtime; therefore your client should not experience discomfort from a chemical SPF. Also, because peel ingredients such as AHAs can increase skin sensitivity to the sun, be sure to recommend that your client use an SPF of at least 30 daily. We recommend a physical SPF like Invisible Physical Defense SPF 30.
